When to Celebrate, Halifax Problem

Halifax, Sept. 20 (CP).—The Halifax Civil Emergency Committee isn't quite sure when victory celebrations should be held. Nonplussed by the question of whether celebrations should start when Allied troops march into Berlin, when occupation is completed, or when the Reich seeks, or signs, armistice terms, the committee has decided to pass the whole problem on to Ottawa. V-Day plans stress thanksgiving, with services in city churches and at public assemblies.
